

## Induction of Employees and Volunteers

October 2023

## **Policy statement**

We provide an induction for all employees and volunteers in order to fully brief them about the setting, the families we serve, our policies and procedures, curriculum and daily practice.

## Procedures

- We have a written induction plan for all new staff, which includes the following:
  - Introductions to all employees and volunteers
  - Familiarisation with the building, health and safety, and fire and evacuation procedures
  - Ensuring our policies and procedures are read and adhered to
  - Introduction to the parents, especially parents of allocated key children where appropriate
  - Familiarisation with confidential information in relation to any key children where applicable
  - Details of the tasks and daily routines to be completed
- The induction period lasts at least two weeks. The manager inducts new employees and volunteers.
- During the induction period, the individual must demonstrate understanding of and compliance with policies, procedures, tasks and routines.
- Successful completion of the induction forms part of the probationary period.
- Following induction, we continue to support our staff to deliver high quality performance through regular supervision and appraisal of their work.
